I write concerning the attached April 29, 2014 Notice Regarding Proposed RMBS Trust Settlement Agreement ("Notice"). We believe that the Proposed Settlement Agreement referenced in the Notice does not and cannot impact any of the claims of the lead plaintiffs or any putative class member in *Fort Worth Employees' Retirement Fund v. J.P. Morgan Chase & Co., et al.*, No. 1:09-cv-03701 (SDNY) ("JPM Acceptance II"). For the avoidance of doubt, please provide written confirmation by May 21, 2014 that defendants agree that (1) the Proposed Settlement Agreement referenced in the Notice does not release any claims of the lead plaintiffs or any putative

class member asserted in JPM Acceptance II; and (2) defendants will not seek any offset, reduction or credit against the damages sought by lead plaintiffs or any putative class member in JPM Acceptance II arising out of the Proposed Settlement Agreement.
