¹ On November 3, 2014, Construction Laborers Pension Trust for Southern California and Laborers Pension Trust Fund for Northern California filed a notice of appearance and other papers expressing their intention to object to the Settlement, and W&L Investments, LLC filed a letter expressing its intention to object to the Settlement. Although these parties have not moved to intervene in the proceeding, the Trustees do not oppose their appearances. Additionally, the Trustees do not oppose the appearance of JPMorgan Chase & Co., which on October 31, 2014, filed a notice of intent to appear to, among other things, support the Trustees' First Amended Petition and the Settlement.

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
