**AFFIRMATION OF
DAVID H. WOLLMUTH**

David H. Wollmuth, an attorney duly licensed to practice law in the State of New York,
affirms under penalty of perjury and says:

1. I am a member of Wollmuth, Maher, and Deutsch LLP, attorneys for intervenor
the National Credit Union Administration Board, as Liquidating Agent for U.S. Central Federal
Credit Union, Western Corporate Federal Credit Union, Members United Corporate Federal
Credit Union, Southwest Corporate Federal Credit Union and Constitution Corporate Federal
Credit Union, in the above captioned action. I am familiar with the proceedings in this case and
make this affirmation in support of the motion to admit George A. Zelcs, John A. Libra, Max C.
Gibbons, and Matthew C. Davies as counsel pro hac vice to represent the National Credit Union
Administration Board.

2. I am a member in good standing of the Bar of the State of New York, and was
admitted to practice law in 1990.

3. I know from personal experience in working with Mr. Zelcs, Mr. Libra, Mr. Gibbons, and Mr. Davies that they are attorneys of the highest caliber and integrity.

As evidenced by the Certificate of Good Standing attached to the accompanying affidavit of Mr. Zelcs, he is an active member in good standing in the State Bar of Illinois, having been admitted to practice law in Illinois on April 26, 1979. He is also an active member in good standing in the District of Columbia Bar, having been admitted to practice law in the District of Columbia on August 9, 2010.

As evidenced by the Certificate of Good Standing attached to the accompanying affidavit of Mr. Libra, he is an active member in good standing in the State Bars of Illinois and Missouri, having been admitted to practice law in Illinois on November 10, 2005 and in Missouri on April 19, 2006. He is also an active member in good standing in the District of Columbia Bar, having been admitted to practice law in the District of Columbia on August 8, 2011.

6. As evidenced by the Certificate of Good Standing attached to the accompanying affidavit of Mr. Gibbons, he is an active member in good standing in the State Bar of Illinois, having been admitted to practice law in Illinois on July 13, 2004.


7. As evidenced by the Certificate of Good Standing attached to the accompanying affidavit of Mr. Davies, he is an active member in good standing in the State Bar of Illinois, having been admitted to practice law in Illinois on November 5, 2009.

As the affidavits of Mr. Zelcs, Mr. Libra, Mr. Gibbons, and Mr. Davies reflect: (a) these attorneys are familiar with, and agree to be bound by, the standards of professional conduct imposed upon members of the New York bar, including the rules of court governing the conduct of attorneys and the Disciplinary Rules of the Code of Professional Responsibility; (b) these attorneys acknowledge and agree to be subject to the jurisdiction of the State of New York with

respect to any acts occurring during the course of their participation in this matter; (c) there are no disciplinary proceedings pending against these attorneys in the State of Illinois or in any other jurisdiction, nor have there ever been any such proceedings brought against these attorneys in any jurisdiction; and (d) these attorneys have previously been admitted pro hac vice in this Court.
