Dear Nina:

We represent HBK Master Fund LP ("HBK") which, as you are aware, is an investor in 20 NIMS trusts for which your client, U.S. Bank ("U.S. Bank"), serves as trustee. As you are aware, the NIMS trust certificates owned by HBK were issued by RMBS trusts which are at issue in the action styled *In the Matter of the Application of Wells Fargo Bank, National Association, et al. for Judicial Instructions under CPLR Article 77 on the Administration and Distribution of a Settlement Payment, Supreme Court, New York County, Index No. 657387/2017* (the "Article 77 Proceeding").

We write to follow up on our call of January 18, 2018, during which HBK demanded that your client, U.S. Bank, as trustee for the NIMS trusts, immediately inform it of the following: (1) whether U.S. Bank intends to appear in the Article 77 Proceeding as an interested party as trustee for the NIMS trusts to represent the interests of the NIMS bondholders; (2) if not, whether U.S. Bank will expressly assign HBK the right to appear in the Article 77 Proceeding on behalf of the NIMS bondholders; and (3) whether U.S. Bank will agree to join in any filing made by HBK in the Article 77 Proceeding on behalf of the NIMS bondholders. We have not yet received any response from you regarding any of these requests.

Accordingly, we write to inform you that HBK intends to appear in the Article 77 Proceeding, and to make a filing as an interested party as required by the schedule in the Article 77 Proceeding on or before January 29, 2018. As trustee for the NIMS trusts, whose duty it is to protect the interests of all NIMS bondholders, including HBK, it is U.S. Bank's duty to join in this submission. Accordingly, we write to direct U.S. Bank, as trustee for the NIMS trusts, to join in HBK's filing in the Article 77 Proceeding.
