


5. I have previously been admitted *pro hac vice* in this Court.

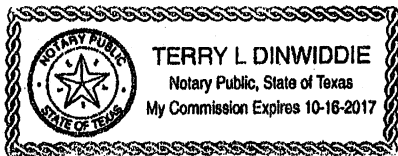
