ORDERED that Mr. Kollmeyer shall be familiar and comply with the standards of professional conduct imposed upon members of the New York State Bar, including the rules of courts governing the conduct of attorneys and the Rules of Professional Conduct; and it is further

ORDERED that Mr. Kollmeyer shall be subject to all disciplinary rules and regulations of the courts of the State of New York and shall notify this Court immediately of any matter affecting his standing at the state bar to which he is admitted; and it is further

ORDERED that Mr. Kollmeyer shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of the State of New York with respect to any acts occurring during the course of his participation in this action.
